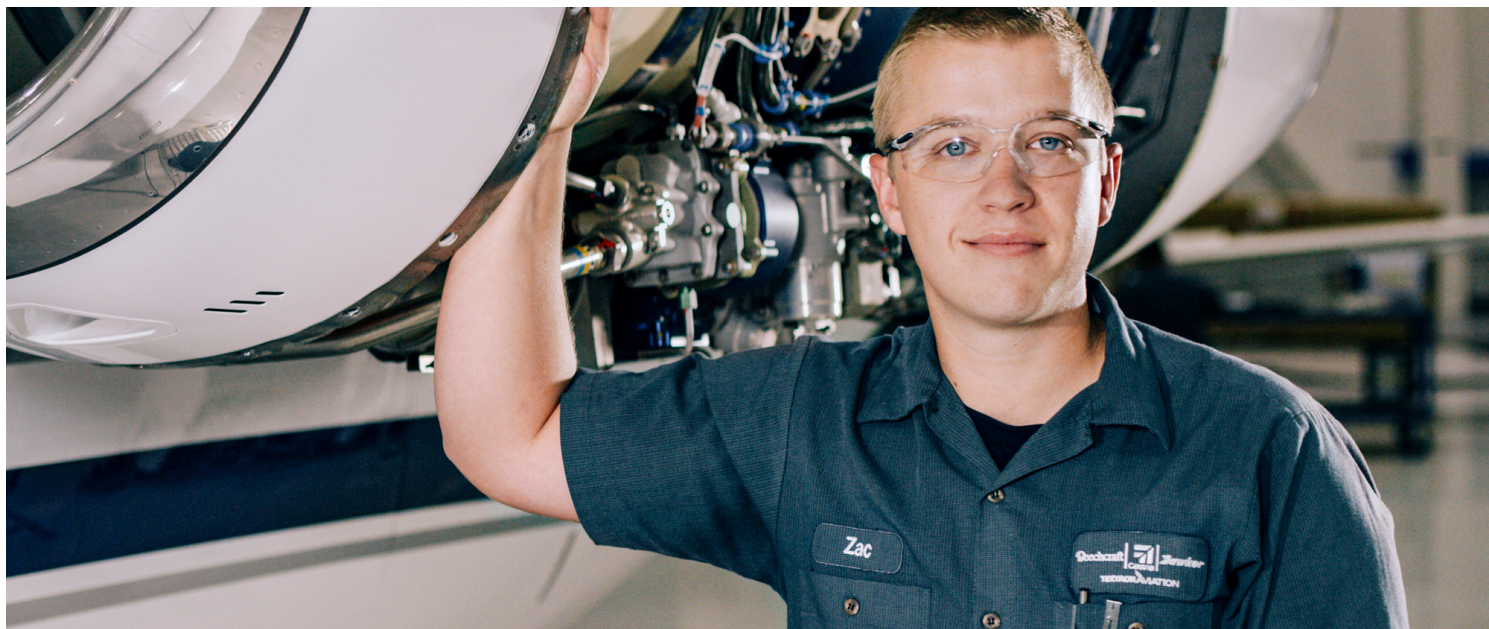

- Kansas ranked #4 among all 50 states for a business-friendly regulatory environment in a non-partisan, non-profit 50-State Small Business Regulation Index (Pacific Research Institute, 2019)
- Kansas is one of only eight constitutional right-to-work states
- Commercial energy rates are 7.3% below the national average
- Kansas offers the 7th lowest industrial natural gas total delivered cost in the nation
- All purchased business equipment receives 100% tax abatement
